

Flinders Health and Medical Research Institute PhD Top-Up Scholarship

Purpose and Aims

The FHMRI Top-up Scholarship will be awarded to PhD candidates who are in receipt of a nationally competitive, externally funded scholarship such as an NHMRC PhD scholarship.

The aim of the top-up scheme is to encourage students to apply for external scholarship funding and to reward their success.

Eligibility

This award is open to all HDR scholars who are awarded a nationally competitive, externally funded scholarship and who undertake a PhD in the College of Medicine and Public Health, with primary PhD supervision by a member of CMPH staff.

The award is not retrospective and will be offered to scholars who are successful in winning externally funded scholarships from 2019 onwards. Scholars must apply for the top-up within the first 12 months of their scholarship.

Funding

The FHMRI Top-Up Scholarship will provide \$5,000 p.a. for full-time students (pro rata) for up to 3 years, or the duration of the externally funded scholarship, up to a maximum of \$15,000.

Applications

Applications can be made at any time in the candidate's first year of external scholarship funding.
