5 6 7	Check attachments in FlinSafe for the Boating Safety Plan form which will contain important contact details of the Coxswain/ Skipper, vessel AMSA ID/ registration, area of operation, nearest Coast Guard/ Sea Rescue etc. If using a Flinders vessel, check Boat booking calendar —to help identify vessel missing. Check with College Boating contacts and/ or technical staff for returned boats, vehicles or gear if participants/leader are not contactable.	Call Coxswain/ Skipper, note, contact number will be listed on the FlinSafe Boating Safety Plan form. Can also try and contact via VHF Radio on Ch 16 if out of phone range. 8	Phone University Security (on 8201 2880, available 24 hrs. a day) and confirm no calls have been received. Instruct Security to go down to the Sturt Maritime Operations (Boat Shed) to confirm that the boat is not back onsite?	Flinders University Security - 8201 2880
9	Contact local volunteer Sea Rescue/ Coast Guard to confirm any late scheduled call or missed schedule call. If so Sea Rescue/ Coast guard to regain contact via VHF radio Ch 16 or if no contact, initiate a local volunteer search and rescue response. SA Coastal radio network.	Contact local volunteer Sea Rescue/ Coast Guard - Refer to FlinSafe Boating safety plan form or the Boats and Boating activity web page - Flinders Uni boats listing to provide vessel details and vessel tracking AIS/ MMIS numbers where applicable.
