

# **DEGREE MANAGEMENT - STUDENT QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE**

### **OVERVIEW**

This guide explains how to apply for variations to your degree such as:

- Applying for an intermission of candidature
- Applying for an extension of candidature
- Changing or adding a Supervisor
- Transfer from full-time to part-time or vice versa
- Changing enrolment location
- Transferring degree or applying for a significant change to your research project
- · Withdrawing your enrolment



## **COMMON QUESTIONS**

### 1. Where are the Student Enrolment Variation forms?

Select **Degree Management** and a drop-down menu appears. Hovering over each Form Name highlights the title in yellow. Select the form for the correct application you would like to submit.





### 2. How do I submit an application?

Open the form by selecting the blue labelled button. The form appears in a separate pop up window in the same browser tab.

# Change Enrolment Location



**Please note:** Once you click the 'Apply' button, the form is created, and stays on your record, unless you either delete it or submit it. The 'Discard' button only Discards changes, not the form.


To delete the form, you must select '**Delete**' next to the selected form. Once a form is submitted you are no longer able to delete the form.

Fill in the form, including all mandatory fields marked with a red asterisk. You also need to upload any required mandatory documentation\* and electronically sign the form.

**Please note:** document names need to be succinct and not contain any special characters such as apostrophes.


Once signed the form must be submitted by using the 'Submit" button in the top right-hand corner of the form.







You will then be asked to confirm your submission before sending.



Upon submission, you will be sent an email notification that your form has been submitted and is now awaiting approval in the process.

**Please note:** if the form says the Application is "**In Progress**" then you have not submitted your part. The status will switch to "**Form Submitted**" when it has gone to your supervisor.

### 3. What happens to my form once submitted?

Each student type has a different workflow depending upon your circumstances.

All forms go to the Principal Supervisor first for a recommendation. Supervisors are sent an email of their 'forms requiring attention' every Tuesday. If your request is urgent, once you have successfully submitted it, please contact your supervisor and ask them to log into Inspire.

If you are an International student, your form is sent to the International Compliance Office for verification that the form is permitted to proceed without further information or variation to conditions of the form.

If you are a Scholarship or Sponsored student, your form is sent to the Student Finance Office for verification that any variations to your enrolment will not have an impact upon your Scholarship or Sponsorship agreements.

All Student forms pass through the Office of Graduate Research for approval or review. If required, forms may be sent to the HDR Coordinator of the associated College for a decision.


Email notifications for Administrative roles are sent each Tuesday and Thursday. Forms requiring action can be found on the user's Inspire Dashboard at any time.

### 4. Can I view the progress of my application?

Yes, you can log into your Inspire account and view the progress of your application at any time.

A student Dashboard shows each step in the workflow in date chronological order. It displays the status as 'Form Submitted' or 'In Progress' with the Deadline of when the form is required to be actioned if not submitted.





## 5. Can I view comments on the progress of my application?

Yes, you can see each comment added to your application. Below is an example of the final OGR approval and comment. This system creates total transparency.



## 6. Will I be notified of the outcome of my applications?

Yes, final outcome email notifications will be sent to you, your supervisor and other staff involved in the process.
